

### New Brunswick's interprovincial migrants aged 5 years and over

- Between 2011 and 2016, 29,340 individuals moved to New Brunswick from elsewhere in the country, with the majority of them coming from Ontario (31.1%), Nova Scotia (19.6%), Quebec (15.8%) and Alberta (14.6%).
- At the same time, 37,170 people left New Brunswick for other parts of Canada. Most of these individuals went to Ontario (25.5%), Alberta (25.2%) and Nova Scotia (18.3%).
- Considering both arrivals to and departures from the province, New Brunswick suffered a net loss of approximately 7,800 people over the five-year period.
